The Parish Council, at the meeting on 11th November 2024 deferred a decision on two grant applications pending further information.

2 Corsley War Memorial Playing Field - £1,600

To support the insurance and running costs of the Playing Field.

The annual accounts are attached.

3 Jon De Groot - £750

To purchase materials to enable the old school staging to be repaired and made usable again.

The material to be used, Buffalo Board:

An Anti-Slip Mesh Phenolic Resin Hardwood Plywood that has been designed and manufactured especially for internal & external applications such as farmwork, shop fitting, trailer bases, walkways and multiple other uses. It is Long-lasting – each board has a shelf life of more than 20 years and durable. Apart from being water-resistant, phenolic boards are also resistant to fire, cracks, scratches and graffiti, and can be used for both wet and dry applications.

Storage – It has been confirmed that the repaired staging can be stored in the Reading Room.

Ownership/responsibility – The staging originally belonged to Corsley school. It was last used for the Ceilidh, at the Corsley Fayre of 2023. It is to be stored in the Reading Room and while it is to be viewed as a community asset it is recommended that the point of contact should be the Reading Room committee.
