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Six Open Doors

Dear Friends,

Have you ever wondered why our parish magazine is called 'The Bridge'? As always there is a history attached, as I learnt at our informal second Sunday of the month service in June. At which Ian Buick reflected on the physical and social importance of bridges. Many will be aware that the Victoria Bridge in Bath was designed and built in 1836 by James Dredge, who was born in Chapmanslade. An innovative design which created an important link across the river. It also enabled James Dredge to move his beer (he was also a brewer) across! There is a memorial plaque to James Dredge in the drive between the church and the school.

St Philip and St James' church was built in 1867 to provide a unifying link too. To be a spiritual, social and community focus across the then parish divide. At that time the north side of the High Street was in Dilton Marsh, whereas the south side of the High Street was part of Corsley. Other parts were in Upton Scudamore. It was not until 1934 that the present civic parish of Chapmanslade was created. Meanwhile Diocesan boundaries too underwent various changes.

It made sense therefore that the title 'The Bridge' was chosen for the then new parish magazine for Corsley and Chapmanslade, to highlight this joining together of a parish that had previously been somewhat disparate. It reflected too the road bridge across Rodden Brook, the physical link. 70 years later the title remains unchanged.

The building, or perhaps rebuilding, of bridges is very much what, we as churches, are currently seeking to do within and across our communities. In Chapmanslade in particular, we are planning to transform the church to become a community facility. We recognise that this will require better facilities, a small kitchenette, a toilet (to replace the festival loo) and more comfortable seating, so that we can create a more welcoming environment. The vision is for greater flexibility with how our churches can be used, with the objective that the whole community, not just church goers, can enjoy and benefit from our buildings.

Another important part of this is strengthening our partnership with the school and supporting them in their important and increasingly challenging role. At a time when the world is changing, when there is much uncertainty, much to be concerned about, it feels important that our churches can be part of a shared, participative, whole community model. That we can be there, along with others, to support, care for, strengthen and bring stability within our communities. And for us, as part of that, can keep the distinctive light, love and hope that our faith in Jesus brings us, present too.

We are grateful that, after a three-year vacancy, we will be welcoming our new Rector, Rev Mark Windsor in September. We look forward to working together with Mark, and with God's help, to be a parish where bridges are rebuilt and relationships strengthened over the coming years.

Go well, and enjoy the summer!

June news

Alice Helliard rounds up the June meeting



Our June meeting explored topics often avoided as the need for them can leave us feeling uncomfortable. We were discussing ‘Wills and Lasting Power of Attorney documents (LPAs)’ with Jane Healey from Forrester Sylvester Mackett Solicitors in Frome. Her message was simple – we all need them!

LPAs replaced the singular Enduring Power of Attorney and come in two forms – one for financial decisions and another for health and care-related choices. Both are powerful documents, giving someone the legal authority to make decisions on your behalf if you no longer can.

While many people are left incapacitated through catastrophic health conditions or accidents, ‘preparing’ for dementia is also a common reason for considering the appointment of an attorney. Approximately one million people in the UK are living with dementia, increasing to 1 in 5 of those over 85 years old.

And Jane was at pains to point out, if an LPA is not in place when mental capacity is lost, the alternative, called a deputyship order, takes time and money.

Turning to wills, Jane was equally insistent of their importance. As the legal document which enables your estate to be divided according to your wishes, it is possibly surprising up to 60% of UK adults don’t have one.

To lighten the tone at the end of the evening, WI members were asked to suggest an eccentric wish they might leave in their will.

Our next meeting is on Thursday 9th July at 7.30pm in the Reading Room. Debs Marrison will be sharing her ‘Millinery Journey’. As always, non-members are welcome. The meeting cost of £6 includes refreshments.

Training event

Emergency planning

Corsley Parish Council is organising a training event at Corsley Memorial Playing Fields for community volunteers from Corsley, Chapmanslade and Horningsham. Exact dates and timings will be confirmed nearer the time, but it is likely that it will take place from 4.30 to 7.30 pm on Wednesday 19th August. The event is intended to help strengthen local preparedness and resilience by bringing together volunteers with subject matter experts from a range of organisations, including the emergency services, flood resilience specialists, and utility providers such as SSEN and Wessex Water. The programme will cover a range of topics relevant to community emergency response, including:

- The hazards and risks facing our local communities
- The types of incidents and scenarios volunteers may be involved in supporting
- Personal safety and risk management
- Basic first aid and casualty care
- Emergency communications and coordination
- Equipment and resources available within our communities
- How volunteers can support vulnerable residents during emergencies.

The aim is to provide practical knowledge, build confidence, and strengthen links between local volunteers and the professional organisations that support our communities

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*Five times I received ... the forty lashes minus one.
2 Corinthians, 12:24*

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Here at Whitbourne, our congregation is so dispersed in different directions, that a Bible Study programme in-situ was impossible. Until now. One of our guitarists, Adrian, tried out an on-line 'Bible Plan' recently and found it so successful, he thought we could use the same 'app' as our Bible Study. His first choice was the Apostle Paul's Letter to the Romans and I said I'd give it a try, but didn't think it would work on my mobile or laptop. I feared pressing a wrong button or two and getting in serious trouble of some kind... Adrian spent two weeks and more trying to fill me with confidence in the technology.

When the group moved on to Paul's first Letter to the Thessalonians, I read it too, but in my Bible. The word 'afflictions' appeared and I blinked, remembering another of

Paul's letters, in which he listed the beatings and other disasters he suffered, as Christ's emissary to the Gentiles. In 2 Corinthians, chapter 12, we read: 'Five times I received from the Jews the forty lashes minus one. Three times I was beaten with rods, once I was stoned, three times I was shipwrecked, I spent a night and a day in the open sea...' Did he duck out of his work for Christ? Not him! All I needed to do was press a few buttons, to better understand Christ's love for us all.

We've just finished that first Letter to the Thessalonians – and I mean 'we'. It wasn't so difficult in the end; my mind just decided it would be and the barriers seemed insurmountable. They weren't. I managed the readings online, read the guiding notes and even commented in the spaces provided! All it took was nerve and perseverance!

If you'd like to try a Bible Plan for yourself at home, you can download The You Version Bible App from <https://play.google.com> or from the Google Play Store on your Android device. If you are an Apple user, then download from the Apple App Store. Once downloaded, there are numerous plans and readings you can sign up to. Why not give it a try?!



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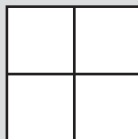
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
